Who attends Community Colleges ?

- Average age around 25.
- Women comprises 60 per cent of the student body.
- 39 percent of the students are first generation learners.
- Minorities comprises 35 percent of community college students.
- 27 percent of community college students are employed fulltime and 50 percent are employed part-time .
- 47 percent of community college students received financial aid.

Importance of Community colleges in Madhya Pradesh and Chattisgarh:

- Largest youth populations are struggling for job.
- Only 5% of Indian labour forces in the age group of 20-24 have obtained vocational skills through formal means (Industrialized countries 60-96%).
- Only 2.5 million vocational training seats are available where as 12.8 million enter the labour market every year.
- Largest share of new jobs likely to come from the un-organized sector which employs up to 93% of the national workforce.
- Community Colleges in certain parts of India emerged out of the growing needs of unemployed youth and disadvantages sections of the poor who usually fail to acquire skills for gainful employment.
- Winds of new changes are blowing across the global job market and the impact of these changes is evident in the way. Therefore, CEDMAP has initiated to enhance the job oriented skills through community college in M.P. and CG so that the maximum advantages can be utilized by the lower groups.
